

NWF Rulebook 2024

Group Stage:

- 12 teams are divided into 2 groups: Group A and Group B.
- Each group consists of 6 teams.
- Each team will play one match against every other team in their group.
- Group stage matches are 9 minutes long.
- The top 2 teams from each group will advance to the knockout stage.

Semi-Finals:

- Starting Order: To determine the order of play, the top players from Group A and Group B will participate in a coin toss.
- Match 1: 1st place in Group A vs. 2nd place in Group B.
- Match 2: 1st place in Group B vs. 2nd place in Group A.
- Match Duration: Each semi-final match is 15 minutes long.

Final:

Match Duration: The final match is 20 minutes long.



- There is ZERO tolerance for physical and verbal abuse. Teams will be disqualified IMMEDIATELY and banned from all future tournaments and events.
- Sliding is strictly prohibited. The first offense will result in a warning; a second offense will lead to a sending-off. Players may be sent off after the first offense at the referee's discretion.
- Penalties are limited to a single step. Whether or not a penalty was taken correctly is subject to the referee's judgment. Retakes are not permitted.
- Goalkeepers are allowed outside of their penalty area.
- No back-passes are allowed. A back-pass will result in a penalty kick for the opposition.
- No throw-ins are permitted.
- If the ball goes behind the net, a goal kick will be awarded. Teams deliberately attempting to earn goal kicks will concede a free kick to the opposing team.
- Free kicks are direct.
- Players are allowed inside both their own and the opposing team's penalty area.
- A maximum of 3 substitutes is permitted for 5 and 7-a-side tournaments.
- Time-wasting through fouls or goal kicks will result in a sin-bin penalty.
- The duration of a sin-bin penalty is 4 minutes.
- All rules are enforced at the referee's discretion.



- Multiple sliding offenses by any team will result in the offending player being removed from the game. Referees have the discretion to send off a player for a
- single sliding offense.
- Any dissent towards the referee will result in a sending-off.
- Any physical altercation will lead to immediate disqualification from the tournament.



- Teams are required to bring their own balls for use off the pitch. NWF will only provide match balls.
- While shin pads are recommended, they are not mandatory.
- Appropriate footwear is advised; metal studs are strictly prohibited (No Exceptions).
- Players are not permitted to wear any jewelry during matches.
- Please dress appropriately for the occasion.

These rules are designed to ensure a fair, safe, and enjoyable tournament for all participants. Compliance with these regulations is mandatory.

NWF reserves the right to permanently ban and remove players/teams from present & future tournaments.
